Oakwood Handicap Route

We meet up at Springwood Leisure Centre but there is more parking further up the road at the community centre.

In simplistic terms the Oakwood Route is very simple with just 5 turns to remember.

- 1. At roundabout 1 turn <u>left.</u> You will need to cross the road before the next roundabout and best visibility is as you drop down the hill BUT there is a reservation at the island.
- **2.** At roundabout 2 turn <u>right.</u> Once again you will need to cross the road and there is a reservation at the island.
- **3.** At roundabout 3 turn <u>left.</u> After this roundabout the road is a 40mph road but there is absolutely no need to step into the carriageway with a footpath all the way.
- 4. After the post box turn <u>left</u> onto Smalley Drive. By the end you will again needed to have crossed the road but there is plenty of opportunity to find a safe place.
- 5. At the END of Smalley Drive turn <u>right.</u> You will want to be on the left when you reach the finish but there is visibility and traffic calming and crossing is rarely an issue
